

# TAKE THE FRUSTRATION OUT OF LEARNING TO READ

Learning to Read Should NEVER Hurt



## ALLOW CHOICE

Let children choose from any type of text: sports trading cards, recipe books, picture books, graphic novels, ANY book they are interested in.

## RECORD IT

Record an adult as they model what great reading sounds and looks like. Record children learning to read - play it back and talk about it



## ADD SILLY VOICES

Add dynamics to any text by using a variety of fun voices. Take turns reading like different animals and changing pitch & volume.



## USE PUPPETS & PROPS

Add puppets and props such as hats, scarves, or costumes to make any shared reading experience more interactive. Create a prop box to use.



## PHONE A FRIEND

Use video calling to read to a beloved family member that is far away. Make this an evening ritual before bed or any other time.



## REPEAT

Repeated readings have been shown to be super effective in building fluency. Let children read their favorite texts over and over and over again.
