Use Puppets To...

1 Communicate

Build early language and literacy skills. Sing a song or a story; mime, teach greetings and good-byes.

Support Literacy Skills

Play rhyming games, tell a story, retell a story, sing the alphabet, add sound effects to a story & more!

Support SEL

Use as a mediator, role-play, express feelings, problem solve, teach choices, sharing, safety.

Be a Classroom Helper

Use as a leader to introduce new words, texts, lead discussions, and increase engagement.

5 Learn a New Language

Use to teach sign language, other languages, celebrate diversity & culture etc:

6 To Model Expectations

Use to show what expectation behaviors look like: good listening etc. Use as a tour guide.

7 Improve Reading Fluency

Use puppets & scripts: improve speed, accuracy, & prosody. Sing, talk, whisper. Include dynamics.

8 Teach Science

Light & Shadows: include shadow puppets & shadow box theaters. Use hard & soft light features.

9 Write & Draw

Encourage early writing skills: write or draw a letter to puppet; cards, story murals, lists, signs, menus etc.

10 Make Puppets!

Turn anything into a puppet: glove, stick, marionettes, etc. Use spoons, straws, dowels, tubes etc.
