1 Use Academic Identities

Add interest inventories & Getting to Know You/Chit Chat cards to drive content are literacy learning!

2 Read Like A Specialist

Read, think & learn like a mathematician, scientist, etc approach reading differently.

3 Include Wide Reading

Expose students to many different sources; include book/text exploration time etc.

4 Create Community

Include student voice & choice: integrate a layered curriculum, choice boards, etc.

5 Vary Response Options

Consider performance & product alternate assessments: panel talks, role playing, debates, gallery walks etc.

6 Use Shared Reading

Add spoken rounds, choral read, jigsaw reading, close and CLOZE practices and rich discussions.

7 Include Authentic Writing

Add depth through authentic tasks: create an ad, autobiographies, book jackets, math solutions, proofs etc.

8 Weave in the Arts

Integrate reading & writing connections: musical or art reflective/response journals etc.

9 Create a Symbol Board

Like a word wall: morpheme charts for math & science, acronym & abbreviations etc.

10 Inspire, Engage & Motivate

Include rhythmic tongue twisters, create podcasts; sound stories, pair sound effects, etc.. that are connected to objectives
